The CGHE annual conference returns for its sixth edition in 2021, taking place online as a virtual conference.




The **Reception** area is the landing section of the conference platform. You will find overview details of this year's event and the format it will take, including a description of the conference and a welcome video about this year's event.





Basic rules for interaction

The CGHE Annual Conference will be an interactive event for everyone. Attendees will have the opportunity to ask questions directly by switching on their camera and microphone to do so.

We ask that you keep yourselves muted unless you have been invited to ask a question. There's no need to have your camera on during the session, but please do so when asking a question. We recommend using the 'Speaker View' so you can more clearly see who is talking. It would also be ideal if you could display your full name in Zoom.

To ask a question, please use the chat function and write out the question you wish to ask. At the end of the presentation, if your question is selected you will be invited to ask it yourself directly.

When invited to ask a question, please unmute yourself, switch on your camera, and state your name and where you are from.

The main sessions will be recorded and will be posted online after the conference.

A transcript of the chat function conversation will also be posted.
